7th edition of the Diversity Day Lëtzebuerg

The 7th edition of the Diversity Day took place in the Grand Duchy on May 20, 2021. This day is part of the European Commission's European Diversity Month. Organisations were invited to launch initiatives to illustrate their commitment to diversity themes through striking and entertaining actions.



In Luxembourg, on this day coordinated by the Diversity Charter Lëtzebuerg, 6 organisations received Ms Corinne Cahen, Minister for Family Affairs, Integration and the Greater Region and Patron of the Diversity Charter Lëtzebuerg.

On the programme of this #DiversityDay21: a day highlighting the different forms of diversity and proposing awareness-raising activities on disability, LGBTI inclusion, diversity as a corporate value or cultural and culinary diversity.
